SUBJECT: **Engagement of Service for the Development of the Case Management System**

Pursuant to the ongoing pandemic, the Civil Service Commission (CSC) in Memorandum Circular 10, s. 2020 continued to allow government agencies to adopt alternative arrangements in areas placed under GCQ as a means to curb the spread of the pandemic. Because of the alternative work arrangement adopted by the National Privacy Commission (NPC), the NPC Bids and Awards Committee (NPC-BAC), hereby issues this Supplemental/Bid Bulletin to guide the bidders with regard to NPC's procedure with regard to the procurement of Case Management System , to wit:

How will NPC undertake the procurement activities for this item?	The Government Procurement Policy Board (GPPB) has issued GPPB Resolution No. 09-2020 enjoining procurement entities to maximize the use of existing rules under RA No. 9184, its IRR and related issuances on the conduct of procurement activities, particularly those meant to streamline, simplify and expedite the conduct of procurement and address the challenges and disruptions brought by calamities and crisis such as the COVID-19 pandemic. As such, the use of videoconferencing, webcasting and similar technology in the conduct of any of the meetings and
