TERMS OF REFERENCE

ANNUAL EMPLOYEES' APPRECIATION DAY: PLAQUES

I. BACKGROUND

The National Privacy Commission (NPC) is the country's privacy watchdog: an independent body mandate to administer and implement the Data Privacy Act of 2012 and to monitor and ensure compliance the country with international standards set for data protection. The law was passed in 2012, but it was only in 2016 that the first Privacy Commissioner was appointed, and the secretariat was formed.

In its pursuit of achieving its vision as the world-class regulatory and enforcement agency upholding the right to privacy and data protection while ensuring the free flow of information and commitment to excellence, its workforce have served as the backbone that dedicated their time, and support in realizing its goal. By the end of this challenging year, FY2021, it is the chance of recognize their contribution, dedication, loyalty and hard work to the success of the agency.

In line with the approval of the Policy Guidelines on Awards and Incentives for Service Excellence (PRAISE) of the NPC, all deserving employees will be recognized and rewarded with monetary and non-monetary incentives during the Annual Employees' Appreciation Day, scheduled on Dec 17, 2021. The plaques as non-monetary incentive shall serve as a memoir for the employees to strive harder, pursue excellence and continue personal development.

II. OBJECTIVES

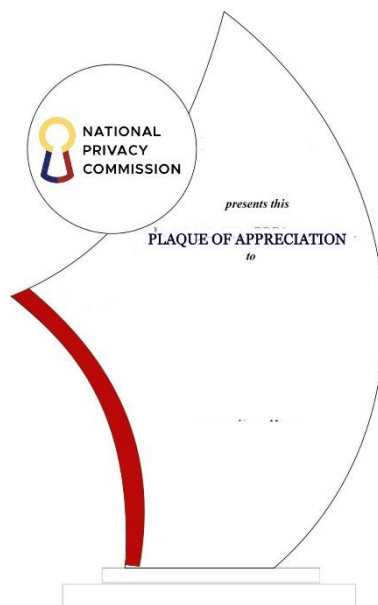
III. TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS/SPECIFICATIONS

A. Technical Specifications:

1. Plaque made of glass material with wooden base

2. Approximate size: 8" width, 9" height and 3" depth (shape indicated in the photo below)
3. With laser engraving
4. Final design/contents will be provided by the NPC thru the Human Resource Development Division
5. Quantity: 1 lot, offer must not be lower than **40 pieces**.

B. Documentary Requirements

The Supplier must have PHILGEPS registration, Mayor's permit, Omnibus Sworn Statement, and other related documents as required by BAC Secretariat.

IV. PAYMENT AND DELIVERY

- Sample plaque must be presented within 10 working days after signing of the Purchase Order/Contract/Work Order
- Full delivery within 15 working days upon approval of the sample/proof or on or before 15 December 2021, whichever comes first

- The NPC-HRDD shall process the payment upon receipt of the following documents submitted by the Supplier:
 - Statement of Account/Invoice/Billing
 - Delivery Receipt
- The supplier/manufacturer/distributor must deliver the goods or perform the services within the period specified by the Procuring Entity, as specified in the Contract. If delays are likely to be incurred, the supplier/manufacturer/distributor must notify the Procuring Entity in writing. It must state therein the cause/s and duration of the expected delay.
- All payments shall be subject to existing budgeting, accounting and auditing laws, rules and regulations.

V. FUND SOURCE AND APPROVED BUDGET FOR THE CONTRACT (ABC)

Approved Budget for the Contract = Php 100,000.00 inclusive of all applicable taxes.
