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TERMS OF REFERENCE

PROCUREMENT FOR WIFI SYSTEM

I. BACKGROUND

The Interim Management Information Unit (IMISU) is acting as Information Technology Division of the National Privacy Commission, it is tasked to supporting, maintaining, implementing Information and Communications Technology (ICT) infrastructure of the National Privacy Commission. With this IMISU intends to upgrade the WIFI system by upscaling to the newest WIFI standards implemented with higher bandwidth capacity, stronger wireless security, and advanced quality of service (QoS).

II. OBJECTIVE

The objective of this procurement is to upgrade the existing WIFI system of NPC, that is more scalable, more stable WIFI access that will support higher bandwidth requirements of day-to-day network operations and activities of the commission.

III. TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS/SPECIFICATIONS

A. Access Point Requirements

1. Bidder must provide at least twelve (12) Long Range Access Points.
2. Must be able to support 802.11 a/b/g WIFI 4/WIFI5/WIFI 6
3. Must be able support WPA-PSK, WPA-Enterprise (WPA/WPA2/WPA3).
4. Must be able support 802.1Q VLAN.
5. Must have Advanced Quality of Service (QoS).
6. Must have Management Interfaces (Bluetooth and Ethernet).

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7. Must have one (1) GbE RJ45 Port.
8. Must have a maximum power consumption of 16.5 W
9. Must be capable of 5 GHz band (4x4 MU-MIMO and OFDMA) with 2.4 Gbps throughput rate.
10. Must be capable of 2.4 GHz band (4x4 MIMO) with 600 Mbps throughput rate.

B. Network Controller Requirements

1. Bidder must provide two (2) network controllers.
2. Must have an eMMC Memory of 32 GB.
3. The processor must have 8 core with 3 GB RAM.
4. Must have a Management Interface.
5. Must have a Networking Interface (10/100/1000) Ethernet Port.
6. Must have a maximum power consumption of 12.95 (PoE) W.
7. Must have a storage capacity of at least 1 TB 2.5" SATA HDD.
8. Must have a built-in battery for automatic safe shutdown.

C. Rackmount Requirements

1. Bidder must provide two (2) rackmounts for the network controller required.
2. Must have RJ45 ethernet connector
3. Must have front panel display.
4. Must be powered by 802.3af PoE DC 5V, 1A.
5. Must have a maximum power consumption of 5W.

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6. Must include cage nuts and bolts.

D. Redundant Power System Requirements

1. Bidder must provide one (1) Redundant Power System.
2. Must be 1U size and rack mountable.
3. Must have one (1) GbE RJ45 Port.
4. Must include one (1) smart power cable.
5. Must have six (6) DC output ports.
6. Must have a maximum power consumption of 995 W.
7. Must have LEDs to show status and link/activity.
8. Must have one (1) universal AC input, 100 to 240 VAC.
9. Must have one (1) 10/100/1000 Mbps RJ45 Port.
10. Must have front touch panel display for monitoring status.
11. Must include Rack mount for the network controller.

E. Cable and Module Requirements

1. Bidder must provide at least six (6) 1G RJ45 (10/100/1000) Modules.
2. Must include at least two (2) SFP+ MM 10G Modules.
3. Must include at least two (2) SFP MM 1G Modules.
4. Must include at least two (2) OM3 Duplex LC-LC connector, 3 meters.
5. Must include at least eight (8) 1.5 M Smart Power Cables.



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F. Functional Requirements

1. The WIFI Access Points must provide high-performance, high-efficiency and powerful coverage within NPC premises.
2. The Network Controller must be able to manage Access Points easily.
3. The Redundant Power System must protect supported devices from sudden power supply failure and provide automatic failover support.
4. The cables and modules must be compatible with existing Ubiquiti switches.
5. Rackmount must be able to secure network controllers.

G. Installation and Configuration Requirements

1. Provider must be able to install, configure and integrate the WIFI system to the network infrastructure of NPC.

H. Warranty, Support and Documentation

1. Provider must have at least one (1) year warranty on parts and service.
2. Provider must provide at least one (1) year technical support assistance / helpdesk support for the end-user.
3. Must have documentation or datasheet available online.

I. Service Level Agreement

1. Technical support assistance must respond via telephone or email to resolve WIFI system technical issues encountered, in which case, severity levels are indicated below:

- a. Severity Level 1, categorized as Minor, the issue must be resolved within one (1) hour after initial report to the service desk or customer support.

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b. Severity Level 2, categorized as Major, the issue must be resolved at the soonest possible time (within 2 hours)

c. Severity Level 3, categorized as Critical, the issue must be resolved immediately (within 4 hours).

IV. PAYMENT AND DELIVERY

100% payment after full delivery, installation and issuance of Inspection and Acceptance Report by the NPC Inspection Committee and certificate of acceptance by the End-user, on or before 28 February 2022 after receipt of Notice to Proceed or Purchase Order.
