## **Advocacy Tokens**

2021 Anti-Violence Against Women (VAW) Culminating Activity on Orientation on Gender-Based Violence: Laws on Anti-Rape, Trafficking, and VAW

#### I. BACKGROUND

Violence Against Women and Children (VAW) remains one of the country's deepest social problems that must be addressed. According to the data gathered by the National Demographic and Health Survey (NDHS), only one-third (1:3) of women (34%) age 15-49 who experienced physical or sexual violence sought help to stop the violence. However, two in five (2:5) women (41%) never sought help to end the violence or told anyone about the violence. Whilst one in four (1:4) women (25%) told someone about the violence but did not seek help.

VAW is regarded to be closely connected to the inadequate influence and authority relation between women and men, also known as "gender-based violence". Social beliefs, norms, and traditions impose that men should be seen as leaders, persecutors, and wage-earners and assume dominant roles in society, while women are the caregivers, partners, and defenders of men and shoulder subordinate roles in society. This impression indicates men to reap and earn more control over women. Therefore, VAW is becoming a form of male expression of control over women to maintain power.

To end the Violence Against Women and in solidarity with women who experienced violence and inequality, the National Privacy Commission Gender and Development Focal Point System-Technical Working Group (NPC GFPS-TWG) shall continue supporting and commencing the 18-Day Campaign to End VAW of the Philippine Commission on Women (PCW) from 25 November until 12 December.

The 18-Day Campaign to end VAW shall embark on the following activities, in harmony with the NPC GAD FY 2021 Plans and Programs:

In unity with the Philippine Commission on Women (PCW) to end the Violence Against Women (VAW), this 18-Day Campaign aims to:


- Raise awareness about the forms of violence experienced by women and girls;
