SUBJECT: Web Cloud Hosting (APP Item No. 2022-0035)

After considering the clarifications and recommendations made during the Pre-Bid Conference dated 25 October 2022 for this procurement, the National Privacy Commission - Bids and Awards Committee (NPC-BAC) hereby issues this Supplemental/Bid Bulletin clarifying provisions in the Bidding Documents, to wit:

CLARIFICATION/ QUESTION	ADDENDUM/AMENDMENT/ ANSWER
<i>Schedule of requirement – whether the 15-day delivery period includes the migration of the project</i>	<p>The delivery period of fifteen (15) calendar days from receipt of the Notice to Proceed / Purchase Order, only refers to the delivery or issuance of the Subscription ID; it does not include the migration from Open License Agreement to Cloud Service Provider (CSP).</p> <p>The migration from Open License Agreement to CSP shall be completed within forty-five (45) calendar days from the issuance of the Subscription ID to the Commission.</p>
<b>ISO Certification</b>  <i>Does the ISO Certification requirement apply to the bid?</i> <i>Do/es the ISO Certification/s need to be submitted with the eligibility documents?</i>	<p>The ISO Certification requirement only applies to the CSP and not to the bidder.</p> <p>No, the ISO Certification/s of the CSP are not required to be submitted with the eligibility documents of the bidder, but presence of such certifications will be verified during the Post-Qualification.</p>

<p>Which shall prevail, the 12-month contract or the budget (actual consumption) for the subscription?</p>	<p>As stated in the Bidding Documents, the contract shall be for a period of twelve (12) months or until the subscription amount has been consumed.</p> <p>The subscription amount refers to the bid price.</p> <p>Thus, the term of the contract is twelve (12) months or until the exhaustion of the bid price, <i>whichever comes first</i>.</p> <p>The bid price should include all the costs and other expenses pertinent to the provision of the subscription, including but not limited to the actual subscription cost, management fee, taxes, etc.</p>
<p>If the subscription amount refers to the bid price, how will the winning bidder be determined?</p>	<p>There may be two (2) instances:</p> <p><b>First:</b> All bidders submitted the <i>same amount</i> of Azure subscription projected spending or consumption, the bidder with the <u>lowest bid price</u> shall be declared the winning bidder, subject to such bidder's compliance with all the legal, technical, and financial requirements provided under RA 9184 and the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR), as amended.</p> <p><b>Second:</b> The bidders submitted <i>varying amount</i> of Azure subscription projected spending or consumption, the bidder with the <u>highest value for the price</u>, even if such bidder is not the lowest bidder, shall be declared the winning bidder, again, subject to such bidder's compliance with all the legal, technical, and financial requirements provided under RA 9184 and the 2016 Revised IRR, as amended.</p>
<p><b>Warranty, Support and Documentation Section 2b</b> Whether the Cloud Service Provider refers to Microsoft Cloud Solution Provider Program.</p>	<p>Since the existing Azure subscription of the Commission is an Open License Agreement, the migration support refers to the migration from Open License to CSP.</p>
<p><b>Azure Kubernetes Service Uptime SLA</b> What OS; What Instance Type;</p>	<p><b>OS:</b> Linux (Ubuntu 20.04 or higher versions) <b>Instance Type:</b> Pay as you Go</p>

<p><i>How large is the storage;</i></p> <p><i>What is uptime SLA?</i></p>	<p><b>Storage:</b> Premium SSD LRS 30GiB (Seeding VMs)   Premium SSD LRS 256 GiB (DB VMs). This is the Commission’s most common and highest specification for its instances.</p> <p><b>Azure Kubernetes Service Uptime SLA:</b> Standard Uptime SLA (It is a tier to enable a financially backed, higher SLA for an Azure Kubernetes Service cluster. The Uptime SLA comes with greater amount of control plane resources and automatically scales to meet the AKS cluster).</p>
<p><b>Azure Site Recovery</b></p> <p><i>How many instances for recovery to customer owned sites?</i></p> <p><i>How many instances for recovery to Azure?</i></p>	<p>Six (6) instances for recovery to customer-owned sites</p> <p>Twenty-seven (27) instances for recovery to Azure (including the customer-owned sites).</p>
<p><b>Azure DNS</b></p> <p><b>How many hosted zones?</b></p> <p><b>How many million queries?</b></p>	<p>None.</p> <p>None.</p>
<p><i>Will the Commission provide a more detailed list / matrix of its existing resources?</i></p> <p><i>The requirement of support resource scalability would entail additional cost and will affect the bid price.</i></p>	<p>Annex A of the Bidding Documents includes all the existing resources of the Commission.</p> <p>This could serve as the basis for the prospective bidder’s bid price or quotation.</p>
<p><b>Annex A NPC Cloud Resources</b></p> <p><i>What is the specific quantity of each instance or resource</i></p>	<p>The table in Annex A already provides for the quantity of types of Service Tiers of the services and instances.
