NWMC Advocacy Tokens (APP Item No. <u>1013-0059</u>)

I. BACKGROUND

The 2023 National Women's Month Celebration highlights a pivotal point in the progression of women's rights by establishing a new recurring theme entitled "WE for Gender Equality and Inclusive Society" that carries out until 2028.

This 2023-2028 new banner is built on the accomplishments made under the 2016-2022 theme entitled "WE Make CHANGE Work for Women", which highlighted the significance of compassion and harmonized partnerships for Gender Equality and Women's Empowerment (GEWE).

This new theme is likewise a constant encouragement and a call to make radical commitments that will contribute to garnering more participation in narrowing gender disparities in the Philippines. According to the country's Gender Development Index (GDI), which measures gender discrepancies in achieving the three (3) basic human development measures namely health, education, and standard of living; it is noticeable that the Philippines demonstrates a huge leap in moving in the right direction toward gender equality as it currently has a GDI value of 0.990 which is +0.004 points higher than in 2021. The nearer the margin is to 1, the narrower the disparity between women and men in the country. This sets the Philippines in Group 1, which is mainly comprised of countries with greater equal opportunities between women and men.

"WE for Gender Equality and Inclusive Society" also conforms with the Philippine Development Plan (PDP) 2023-2038, which strives for "deep economic and social transformation to reinvigorate job creation and accelerate poverty reduction by steering the economy back on a high-growth path." The PDP also emphasizes the importance of inclusive growth, which creates a climate in which all Filipinos experience equal opportunities and are equipped with the skills necessary to engage fully in an innovative and internationally competitive economy.
