TECHNICAL SPECIFICATION

NEWSPAPER PUBLICATION (APP Item No. 2023-0049)

I. BACKGROUND

The National Privacy Commission (NPC) is an independent regulatory body in the Philippines responsible for protecting the privacy rights of individuals and ensuring the secure and accountable handling of personal data through the execution and enforcement of the Republic Act No. 10173 or the Data Privacy Act of 2012 (DPA).

The NPC promotes and raises awareness and education about data privacy rights and obligations by conducting educational campaigns, seminars, and training programs to educate individuals, organizations, and government agencies on the best data privacy practices.

In order to attain this, the NPC, through the Phil-DPO Program, developed competent Data Protection Officers (DPOs) in the country by initiating the DPO Accountability, Compliance, and Ethics (ACE) Training and the Training the Trainers (T3) Program.

The DPO ACE Training capacitates the DPOs with the knowledge necessary to excellently administer the compliance of their respective organizations in accordance with the provisions of the Act, while the T3 Program accredits training providers to broaden the depth and extent of data privacy public education and training throughout the Philippines.

Both DPO ACE Training and T3 Program, however, were ad hoc initiatives and not supported by any type of formal issuances. As such, these will be discontinued.

Considering this, the NPC must systematize and formalize its data privacy courses and training programs under the Data Privacy Competency Program (DPCP) to enhance both accessibility of educational materials and the quality of training programs on data privacy and protection available in the Philippines. Through the DPCP, the NPC aims to enhance the quality of data privacy education in the Philippines, and democratize the cost and accessibility of data privacy education especially outside Metro Manila.

The Circular sets forth the framework of the DPCP. The DPCP consists of courses on the foundational and operational aspects of the DPA that are essential for anyone who seeks to have a better understanding of the law and its application, and other projects on data privacy education. The courses under the Program include (1) a Data Privacy

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Foundational Course, which equips anyone with the basic knowledge to comply with the DPA and its application to real-life situations; and (2) additional courses on more specific data privacy topics.

II. OBJECTIVES

The publication of the Circular in one (1) newspaper of general circulation aims to formally launch the scope and purpose of the DPCP in the best interest of the public.
