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TERMS OF REFERENCE

DATA CENTER EQUIPMENT (APP Item No. 2023-0072)

I. **BACKGROUND**

The Interim Management Information System Unit (IMISU), which is acting as the Management Information Technology Division of the National Privacy Commission (NPC), is tasked with supporting, maintaining, and implementing layers of security in all Information and Communications Technology (ICT) infrastructures of the National Privacy Commission. We currently have two (2) Precision Air Conditioning Unit (PACU) units at the Data Center; they were both installed in 2018. Last year, December 2022, both PACU were already inspected and underwent preventive maintenance. IMISU has found out that one of the unit's compressors needs an immediate replacement to compensate for the alternating operation needed for PACU units. It is important to ensure and maintain the right amount of cooling on the Data Center, a faulty PACU can cause network equipment to heat up and eventually fail and may lead to disruption in the network operations of NPC.

II. **OBJECTIVES**

The purpose of this procurement is to guarantee that the temperature and humidity levels inside the data center operate effectively and consistently to ensure that the network equipment is operating at an optimal level and delivers the desired organizational outcomes for the Commission. Additionally, to increase the longevity of each unit, the two PACU units must operate alternately with no temperature variation.

III. TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS/SPECIFICATIONS

A. **Functional Description**

1. General

- a. It must be a scroll type of compressor designed for high efficiency and reliability in air conditioning, comfort, and process cooling applications, with evaporating temperatures around +5 °C.
- b. It must have features such as brazed fitting connections, tandemization and multiple refrigerant capability provide for the needs of a more demanding market.
- c. The refrigerants compatibilities must be R-22, R-407C, R-134a.
- d. The voltage and frequency range must be 200-220~V at 50~Hz, and 200-230~V at 60~Hz.
- e. It must have the cooling capacity of 14.8 kW.
- f. It must have a power input of 4.64 kW.
- g. It must have a Coefficient of Performance (COP) of 3.19.
- h. It must have an overall dimension of $246 \times 246 \times 451 \text{ mm}$ (W x L x H).
- It must have a net weight of 38.6 kg.

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- j. It must have a low/high side PS of 20/29.5 bar(g).
- k. It must have a maximum operating current of 26A.

2. Service Level Agreement

- a. The supplier is required to remove the damaged compressor, install the replacement compressor, and shall submit a completion report after 10 calendar days of the activity.
- b. The warranty for the compressor should be a minimum of one (1) year.
- c. The supplier must provide onsite technical support for critical issues and must respond via telephone, mobile and email to resolve technical issues related to the compressor that will impede the network operations of the commission, in which case, severity levels are indicated below:
 - i. Severity Level 1, categorized as Critical, the issue must be resolved within one(1) hour after initial report to the service desk or customer support.
 - ii. **Severity Level 2**, categorized as Major, the issue must be resolved at the soonest possible time (within 2 hours)
 - iii. Severity Level 3, categorized as Minor, the issue must be resolved immediately (within 4 hours).
 - d. Supplier Qualification
 - i. PhilGEPS Registration.
 - ii. Mayor's/Business permit.
 - iii. Notarized Omnibus Sworn Statement with applicable attachments (ABC above Php 50,000.00) and Income/Business Tax Return (ABC above Php 500,000.00).
 - iv. Other documents as needed and prescribed under Revised IRR of Republic Act No. 9184.

IV. PAYMENT AND DELIVERY

- 1. Supplier shall provide service acceptance report to confirm completion.
- 2. 100% payment after delivery, installation, and issuance of a certificate of acceptance by the NPC Inspection Committee.
- 3. Supplier shall supply, install, and deliver the Compressor within forty-five (45) days to sixty (60) days to the National Privacy Commission located at 5th floor of PICC Complex, Pasay City after receipt of Notice to Award (NOA) and Notice to Proceed (NTP).
